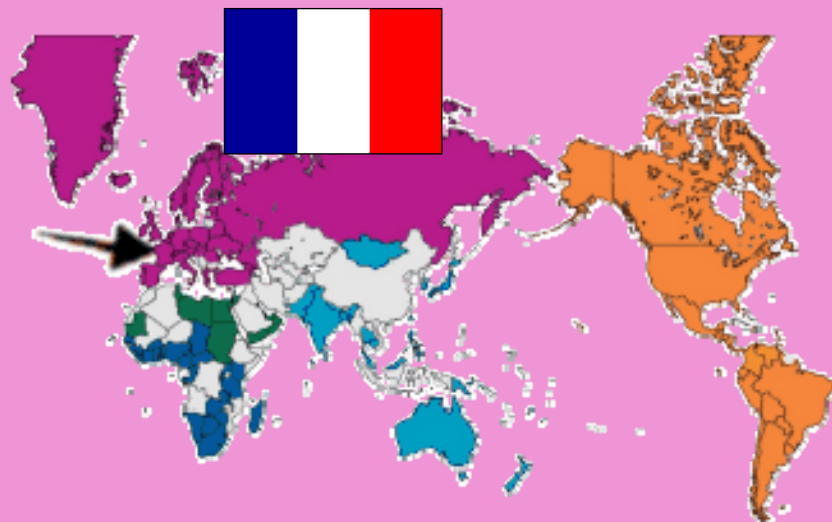

I try to keep the Brownie Law and that of my Hevra (team).



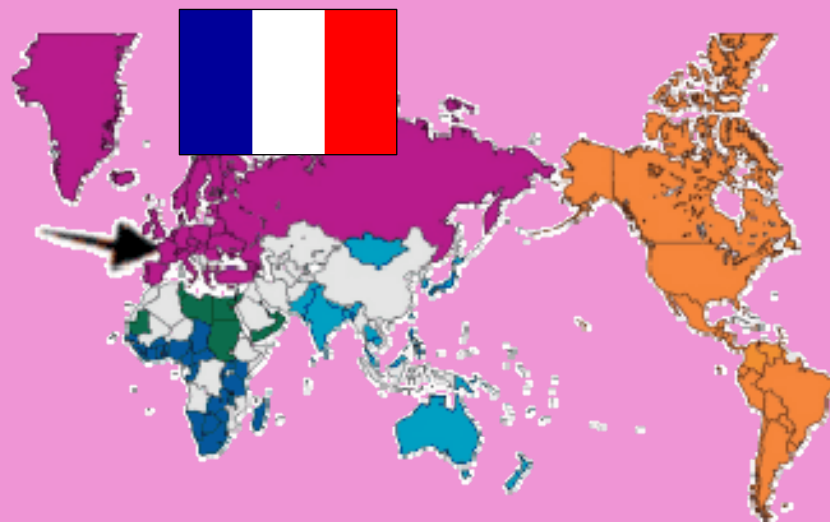

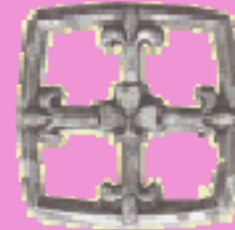

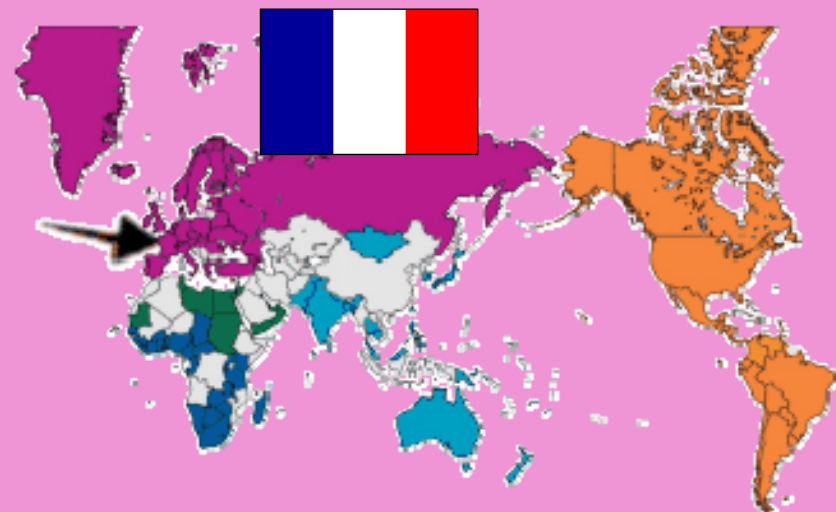

share with the poorest.

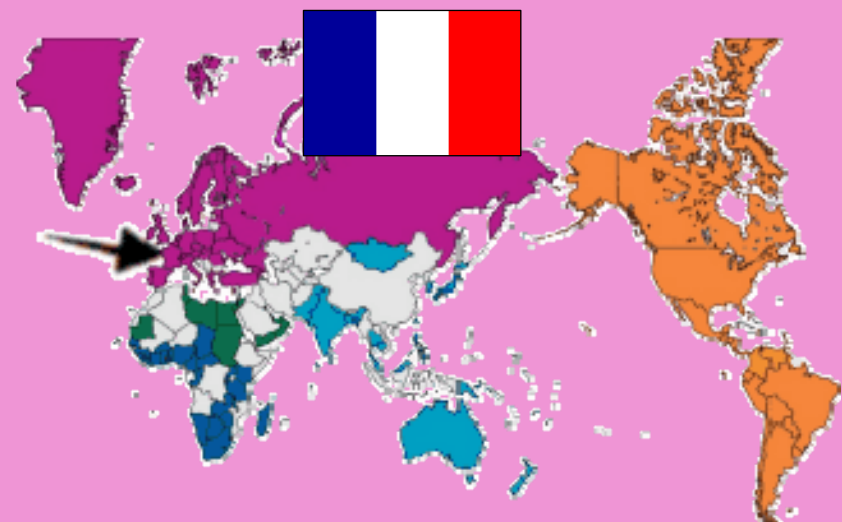
**The Charter of the Youth on the Move**
