I will be a good friend and respect our rules.

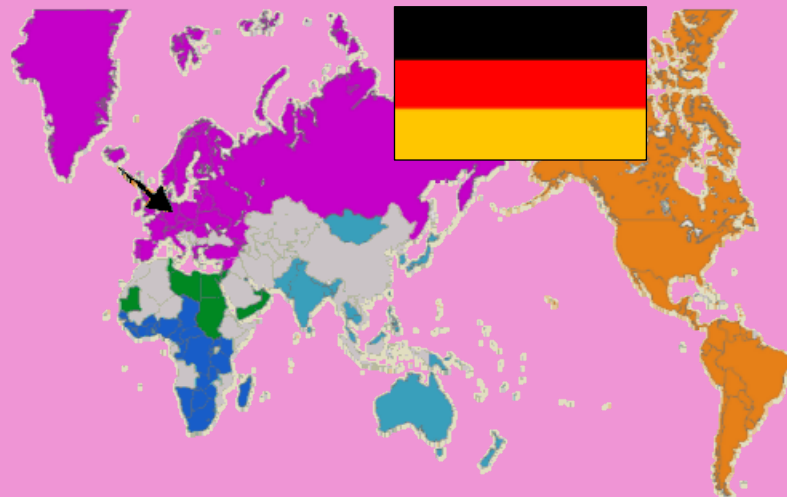

The Association does not have one uniform Promise. On admission, the individual declares her readiness for co-operation and acknowledges the common working group rules.



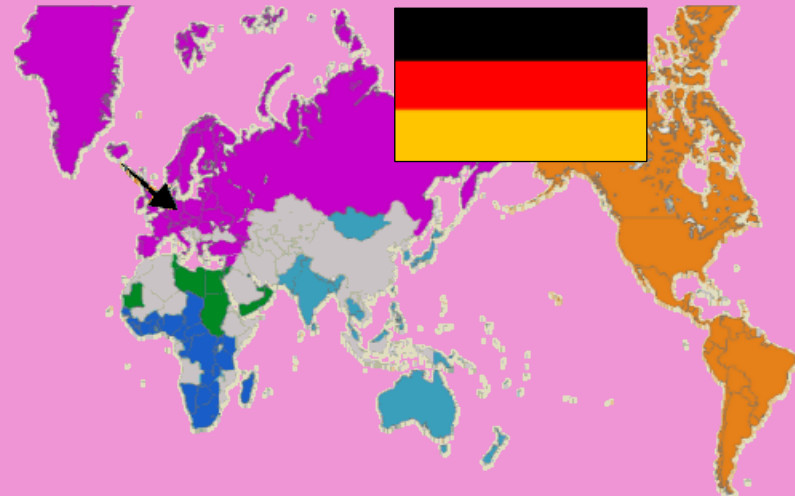

#### Motto

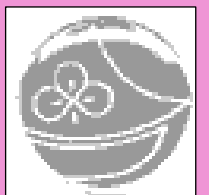
I am willing to do my best
